£7,000 -staffing for 1:1 English and Maths; tutorials;

£8000 – IAG staffing and 1:1 careers planning, application & interview techniques.

£6390 - Alternative Provision – Paget Farm; Mac Motors; Bike Maintenance; Physical problem solving & team building;

£2050 School Counsellor; MeeToo App; Well Being activities - outside the classroom; Home visits to support the child.

BPRU will need to pay the travel costs for the above off-site events (£900 circa)
